5. Principal's Report: Ryan Chamberlin

We are thankful for the SHSA so we can have a Walkathon. Kids are already excited, we will have three different groups walking at different times, in order to minimize the crowd on the field. Teachers will be supervising, yard supervisors also volunteered to come early to make sure our kids are safe.

We will have a Halloween parade on Friday October 29<sup>th</sup>, smaller than usual, no parents will be allowed on campus. We still want to give the opportunity to the kids to show off their costumes! Please keep in mind that younger kids need to be able to change out of their costumes on their own.
