

Schallenberger Home and School Association Membership Meeting Minutes April 5, 2021 @ 6:30 p.m. Virtual WebEx Meeting

1. Call to Order

Officers present: Tayesa Knight (President), Nadege Vatton Raclot (Treasurer), Elise Roussel (Secretary). Quorum present.

2. Approval of Agenda

Motion to approve agenda by Nadege Vatton-Raclot. Ryan Chamberlin seconds the motion. Agenda approved unanimously as written. No opposed. No abstentions. No additional items to add to the agenda.

3. Approval of Minutes from 3/8/22

Motion to approve minutes from meeting in February by Beth Makosey. Nadege Vatton-Raclot seconds the motion. Minutes as written from 3-8-22 approved unanimously. No opposed. No abstentions.

4. President's Report: Tayesa Knight

Please order our SHSA super cute <u>sweatshirts and dry-fit shirts</u> by April 8. We will not buy extra shirts, so pass the word! We will probably sell them again in August for back to school. Our <u>Kendra Scott</u> event will take place on April 23-24, online as well as in store.

We are looking for some help for the <u>teacher appreciation week</u> (first week of May). We would welcome someone or a group of people to give ideas to families and organize the agenda, one idea per day, Monday to Friday (door decoration, flowers, gift cards, food...).

Our <u>Dance Festival</u> will take place on May 20th. Kids will soon receive the papers for pledges and scholarships. Every kid will receive a free Dance Festival t-shirt designed by Danielle. We'll have a <u>new sponsorship level</u> at \$5,000 with an opportunity of marketing advertisements throughout the year via SHSA emails. Each grade level will be assigned a time frame for music and great carnival games we usually use for the Fall Festival. 5th graders may help with the booths. We will probably not have more than six of them, as we don't know whether parents

may help. Campus supervisors will be there to help the teachers supervise the booths. The <u>silent auction</u> will be posted on April 25-29: gift packages for children, adults or couples will be advertised, as well as time or activities with teachers.

Ryan Chamberlin indicated that following our district communication, the <u>volunteer process</u> would be finalized soon. The traditional volunteer process will resume after the spring recess (TBtest / fingerprinting / vaccination proof). Parents will probably be able to chaperone some end of the year field trips and support the teachers.

Beth Makosey informed us that <u>Meredith's corner</u> had been vandalized in the last few days, many things have been damaged ... If someone handy willing to fix tables and benches is willing to donate some time, we would welcome it! We will also use some of the fundraising bucket for the repairs. The personalized brick fundraiser will run again before the end of the year.

5. Principal's Report: Ryan Chamberlin

The school staff is feeling very appreciated with the <u>Monday treats</u>, the spots filled up so fast. Thank you Schallenberger families!

Outdoor activities will resume with the dance festival. We are heading to an almost normal end of the year. Schmahl Science will have their last class in person in April–May. The Dance outdoor performances will probably happen on May 3-4 in the evening. Another possible in-person event would be the open house. School sites have the option of an online or in-person event, depending on the parents' feedback. It would be on May 10^{th} in the evening. Mr. Chamberlin will check with parents during the next Selac and School Site Council meetings too. The 5^{th} grade graduation will be in-person, like we did in the past. No restrictions are planned so far.

<u>CAASP testing</u> will begin in the last week of April, each grade level will have an assigned week so the wifi is not overloaded.

So far, we have sold for \$3,700 of sweatshirts and dry-fit shirts (approx. \$1,700 goes to SHSA). We planned not to have expenses for the dance festival, except the t-shirts for students.
