  - Lindsay question: Art Vista Budget for this year, money did roll over from last year. Julie says that the money did roll over, and they are just needing to talk to Ms Laura to get it figured out
  - Julie coming up to talk about Tayesa’s sentencing
  - She pled guilty; has to pay \$413K in proven missing funds plus 10% penalty (total \$469K)
  - She is done with home arrest due to time served
  - She wanted to clarify about 250 hours of community service
  - Lien is being removed from her home
  - She has 5 years of probation to repay the amount. She gets 2 years of probation no matter what. If after 5 years if she doesn’t repay, she might have to go in front of the court for violating the order
  - 30 people attended sentencing, 10 people spoke and gave victim impact statements, staff, current parents, past parents, vendors, community impact
