- **Guest Speaker** - Autumn Glisson, Emergency Preparedness
  - What to expect as an adult after an earthquake
    - Traffic – longer than usual commute times
    - Network outage – likely overload
    - Utility outages
  - At school
    - Drop, cover, and hold on
    - Evacuation of students
    - School staff will provide assistance
    - Play until it's time to come pick them up
  - Caregivers
    - Make a plan, think about who is closer to the school
    - Update Infinite Campus to add emergency contact
    - Be prepared for a community campout/sleepover
    - Buy bulk snacks
    - 3 gallons of water per person per day (drinking + sanitation)
- **Public Comment/Questions from chat**
  - Question about hearing, \$417K stolen over 4 years, 2 felony counts, theft + white collar enhancement; forgery; pled guilty.
  - Sentencing hearing on Thursday 9/11. She will pay back entire amount + 10%, probation for 5 years, 250 hours of community service, 1 year of time on home arrest
  - Victim impact statements are needed for Julie
  - 9am Thursday Morning, Court 34
  - Victim impact statements help when she is up for moving to misdemeanor
  - She does not have to repay by the hearing. Maybe the judge might change the sentencing
  - 7 years and 8 months is the recommended federal prison time
  - 24 people have said they will attend
